Currently, the cost is approximately \$850+ for a week camp, which includes doctors, nurses, consultants, volunteers and a specialized chef, swimming, kayak, horseback riding, games (to name a few), classes on diabetic maintenance (including insulin shots, blood sugar reading, etc.), educational material, specialized breakfast, lunch and dinner, and menu selections. The chef also does hands-on activities.
